The following scholarships are available to Millersburg Area High School students who will be graduating with their class:

All applications and information are available from the high school guidance office.

I. MILLERSBURG AREA EDUCATION ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship is offered to two seniors at the Millersburg Area High School who are planning to further their education. Applications are available in the guidance office. Deadline is April 27, 2018.

- a. Minimum 85% GPA
- b. Contributions to school and community
- c. Must be enrolling in a four year college

II. ALLEN F. GILBERT TRUST FUND SCHOLARSHIP

These scholarships are to assist any student of the Millersburg Area High School who wishes to pursue, study, or develop his or her talents in any school or university in the United States. There is an application packet from Mid Penn Bank to complete for this award. There is a two-year residency requirement for this award. Deadline is May 1, 2018.

III. WILLIAMSON MEMORIAL TRUST FUND

These scholarships are available to students from Millersburg Area High School. Preference is given to those entering the nursing or medical profession, however, anyone may apply. There is an application packet from Mid Penn Bank to complete for this award. Deadline is May 1, 2018.

IV. HAROLD N. AND THELMA G. LENKER COMMUNITY TRUST FUND SCHOLARSHIP

These scholarships are available to students from Millersburg Area High School. There is an application packet from Mid Penn Bank to complete for this award. Preference is given to those with the greatest financial need and highest grades. Deadline is May 1, 2018.

V. DOROTHY GLUCK FEASTER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship is to assist any student of the Millersburg Area High School for continuing education. It requires a written personal letter of application and a signed contract that may be picked up in the guidance office. Deadline is April 27, 2018.

VI. MARY AND WARREN E. WERT & GERTRUDE C. SCHULER MEMORIAL FUND

This scholarship is for a member of the graduating class who is pursuing a degree in Elementary or Secondary Education. A written personal letter of application is required. Deadline is April 27, 2018.

VII. PAUL A. TROUTMAN FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship is open to high school seniors who intend to pursue a full time course of study at a college or university. This award is renewable for up to four years. Applications are available in the guidance office and must be postmarked by May 30, 2018.

VIII. MUSIC ASSOCIATION*

This scholarship is for a senior member of the band or chorus who is going on to further their education at any post secondary institution. See Mr. Campbell for an application. Applications are due back to Mr. Campbell by April 27, 2018.

IX. WILLIAM C. & DOROTHY T. TROUTMAN MEDICAL SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship is open to seniors who intend to pursue a career in the medical field. A written personal letter of application is required. The letter must mention the student's goals and future aspirations as they relate to some area of the medical field. Deadline is April 27, 2018.

X. JARED B. SHEAFFER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship is for a senior student who will major in Art and/or Music. Applications are available in the guidance office. Deadline is April 27, 2018.

XI. HISTORICAL SOCIETY OF MILLERSBURG AND UPPER PAXTON TOWNSHIP SCHOLARSHIP IN MEMORY OF NANCY L. WERT

This scholarship is open to a senior who will pursue a career in history, journalism, or English through a four year college program. Applicants must submit a personal letter, transcript, three letters of recommendation, and a brief essay. There is also a community service requirement. Please note that to expand the number of students able to apply, any student is eligible as long as their essay demonstrates how their intended area of study relates to or coincides with the field of history. Applications are available in the guidance office. Deadline is April 27, 2018.

XII. AMERICAN LEGION, POST 326, SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship is open to a senior who has an average of 85% or higher and has a parent or grandparent who is a regular or social member of Post 326, Millersburg, PA. Applications are available in the guidance office. Deadline is April 27, 2018.

XII. MILLERSBURG TALL CEDARS SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship is open to seniors with a father, grandfather, or brother who is a Master Mason. Applicants' cumulative grade point average must be a 3.0 (B or better). Applications are available in the guidance office. Deadline is April 27, 2018.

XIV. MILLERSBURG LIONS CLUB SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship is offered to a graduating senior from Millersburg Area High School who exemplifies the ideals of Lions International, whose motto is "We Serve." Applications are available in the guidance office and a written essay is required. Deadline is April 27, 2018.

TIPS FOR WRITING YOUR PERSONAL LETTER OF APPLICATION

The following information could be included in the personal letter of application:

- 1. Name and address of applicant.**
- 2. Name and address of parent or guardian and their place of employment.**
- 3. Name and ages of sisters and brothers.**
- 4. List family member(s) in college (name, year, and college).**
- 5. Name school or college where applicant has been accepted.**
- 6. State reasons for financial aid.**
- 7. Part time jobs held.**
- 8. Extra curricular activities in or out of school.**
- 9. Vocational goal.**
- 10. List any other reason the applicant feels pertinent.**

***Keep in mind that the scholarship committee reads many application letters. Anything interesting that you can include in your letter to help distinguish you from others or make you stand out, may be helpful.**

MAEA SCHOLARSHIP

The Millersburg Area Education Association (MAEA)— your teachers and Applications are available in the Guidance Office.

Requirements

Each candidate must submit the following:

1. A letter stating accomplishments, contributions to the school and community, and future plans and goals
2. A copy of school transcript, including senior year
3. Two letters of recommendation
 - a. one from a faculty member
 - b. one from a community resident who is not related to the candidate

Eligibility

Applicants must meet the following standards:

1. Must be enrolled in a four-year college program
2. Must maintain a consistently high grade average
3. Must make contributions to the community and school

Selection

MAEA members will select names from the list of applicants. Those who receive the most votes will be awarded the scholarships.
